VCE and VCAL Subject Selections for 2007

Dear Parent/Guardian

All students currently in Years 9, 10 and 11 have until Friday 8th of September to submit their VCE and/or VCAL subject selections for 2007.

Parents/Guardians of students currently enrolled in Years 10 and 11 are reminded that they must arrange a meeting with **one** of the following teachers to discuss their child's subject selections for 2007.

- Mr. Bell (For Current Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11 students)
- Mrs. Janes (For Current Year 10 students)
- Mrs. Riordon (For Current Year 10 and Year 11 students)
- Mr. Carter (For Current Year 10 and 11 students)

Parents of current Year 9 students are most welcome to have such a meeting but it is not compulsory.

This meeting needs to take place on or before Friday 8th of September. Parents can elect to wait until Parent Teacher Interviews (Tuesday 29th of August) for this meeting but run the risk of being in a long waiting list. Last year, many parents found this meeting quite productive as they have gained a greater appreciation of the educational options available for their child.

Parents and students should also meet with Mr. Bennett if students are thinking about enrolling as a VCAL student.

MIPs (Managed Individual Pathways): This could be a focus of any meeting between the student and their learning coach. Learning Coaches can assist students in working out their VCE/VCAL Subject Selections.
